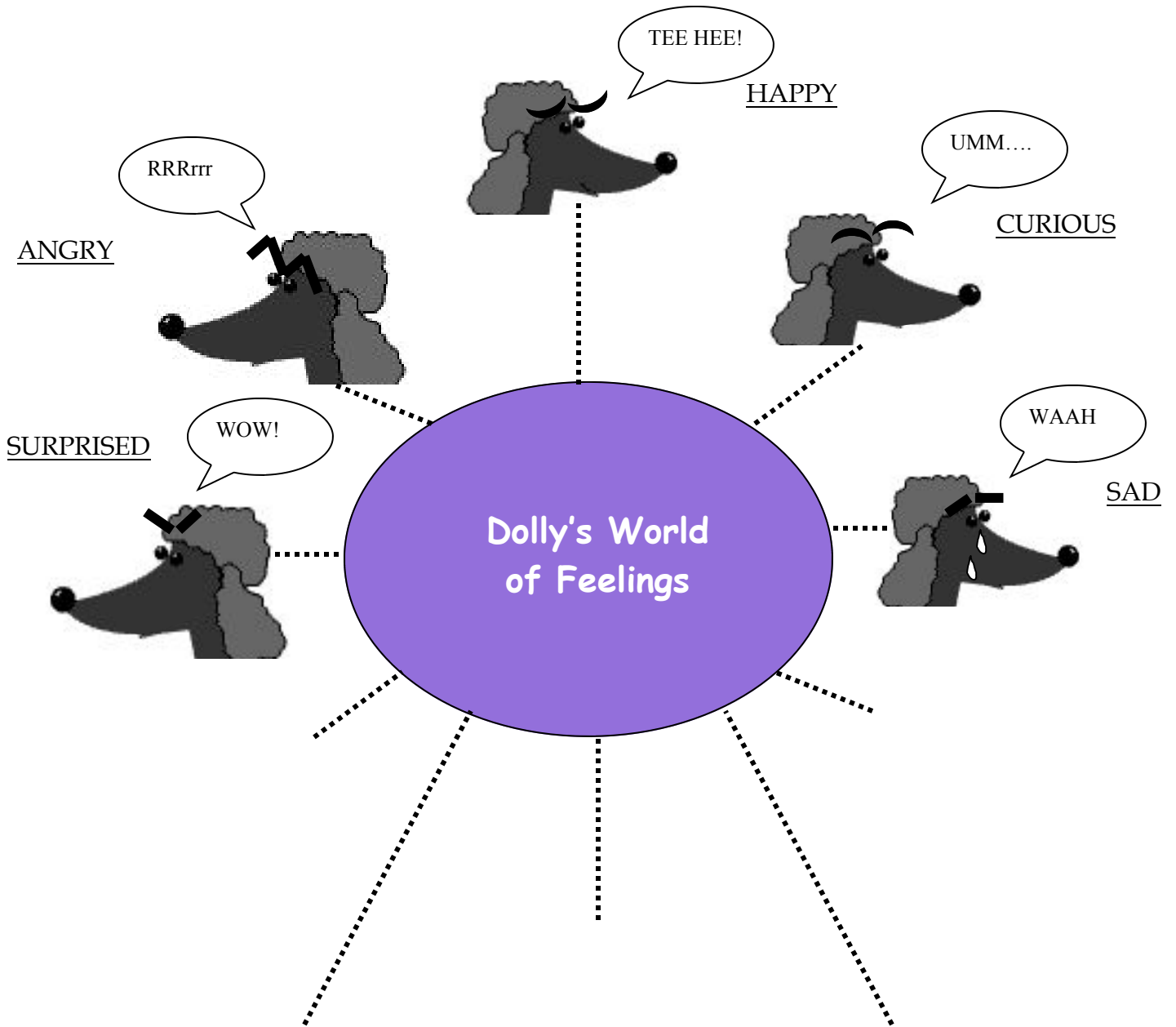

Directions: Help Dolly find the correct path through her feelings maze.

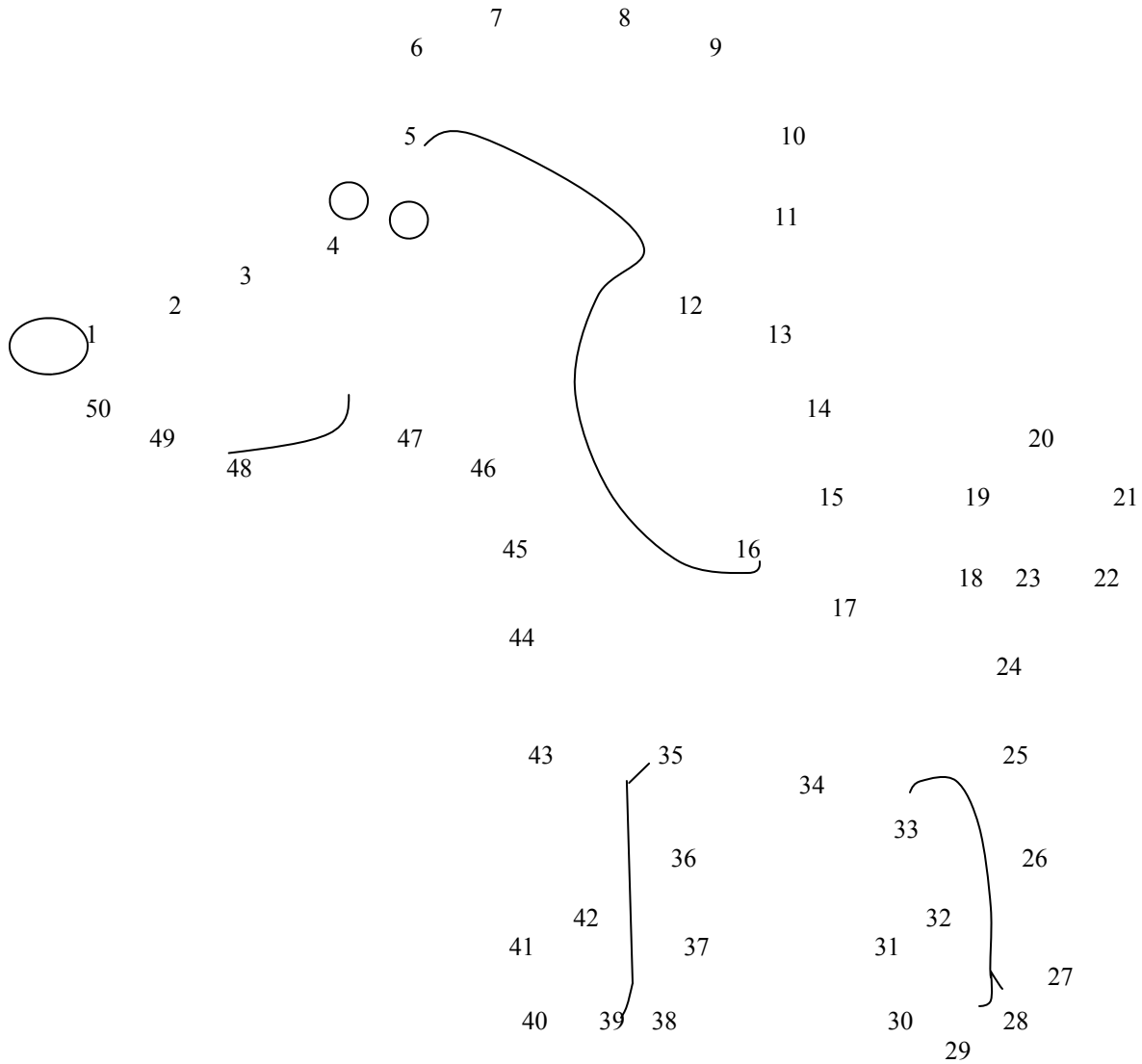
